Instrumental Music	Notification, enrolment and payment	<p>Applications and information booklets for music tuition are available throughout the year from the front office and lessons may begin at the start of any term. For commencement in Term 1, application forms are due by Week 7, Term 4 of the previous year. For continuing students re-enrolment forms are sent out by the Music Coordinator at the end of each year.</p> <p>Students are expected to commit to a minimum of one year's tuition.</p> <p>Fees: \$29 per individual lesson (30 minutes) \$18.50 per shared lesson (30 minutes)</p> <p>Most of the instrumental teachers are private providers and invoice families directly, not through the school. A small music administration fee is levied to cover the cost of the program and its coordination (\$10 per term).</p> <p>Highgate School also offers group tuition for violin, viola and cello for students in years 3 - 7 by Instrumental Music SA teachers <u>free of charge</u>. It is a DECD requirement that students commit to a minimum of one year's tuition.</p>
	Age	<p>Private lessons are available to students at every year level. Group tuition offered by Instrumental Music SA is available to students in years 3 – 7 only.</p> <p>To minimize class disruptions, students are permitted to learn only one instrument during class time.</p>
