- All sports teams are organised and coached by volunteer parents. If the team does not have a coach post registrations, the team cannot be entered in for competition.
- All sports registered for are for a **two** term commitment. The cost associated for each registration is **\$100**.
- Highgate offers school sporting tops for loan for all sports excluding cricket and is covered by the registration fee.

<b>Instrumental Music</b>	Notification, enrolment and payment	<p>Applications and information booklets for music tuition are available throughout the year from the front office and lessons may begin at the start of any term. For commencement in Term 1, application forms are due by Week 9, Term 4 of the previous year. For continuing students re-enrolment forms are sent out by the Music Coordinator at the end of each year.</p> <p>Students are expected to commit to a minimum of one year's tuition.</p> <p>Fees: \$30 per individual lesson (30 minutes) \$18.50 per shared lesson (30 minutes)</p> <p>Most of the instrumental teachers are private providers and invoice families directly, not through the school. A music administration fee of \$40 (\$10 per term) is levied to cover the cost of the program and its coordination and this will be invoiced to parents.</p> <p>Highgate School also offers group tuition for violin, viola and cello for students in years 3 - 7 by Instrumental Music SA teachers <u>free of charge</u>. It is a DECD requirement that students commit to a minimum of one year's tuition.</p>
	Age	<p>Private lessons are available to students in Years 1 to 7. Group tuition offered by Instrumental Music SA is available to students in Years 3 – 7 only.</p> <p>For equity of access to the program, students are permitted to learn only one instrument at school.</p>
